Tony Cambridge, BVMS, Diplomat, American College of Veterinary Surgeons




Appointments

Once you and your veterinarian determine a referral to VSS is in your pet's best interest, please call to schedule an appointment.* Your veterinarian will send us your pet's medical records and you may be asked to bring x-rays or other test results. Many patients require sedation for diagnostic procedures, so please do not feed your pet after 9:00pm the evening prior to your appointment.

**Though patients are seen by appointment, our surgeons are also available to handle emergencies.*

Payment Options and Fees

After a thorough examination, we will provide you with a recommended diagnostic and/or treatment plan along with associated costs. For your convenience, we offer several payment options including cash, ATM, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and financing plans for qualified applicants through Wells Fargo or CareCredit. A deposit is required to initiate treatment with the balance due at the time of discharge.
